### Economic benefits of climate policies **in-district:**



**\$860 million**

Invested in renewable energy, energy efficiency, clean transportation & other climate projects, including Greenhouse Gas Reduction Funds (GGRF)



**11,901** Clean energy jobs<sup>1</sup>



**\$238 million** GGRF funds implemented



**\$216 million** GGRF funds benefiting priority communities<sup>2</sup>




Equivalent of **258,000** cars off the road for one year due to GGRF-funded projects
