



# Clean truck policy will drive investment, job growth and cost savings in **NEW MEXICO**



## Advanced Clean Trucks & Heavy-Duty Omnibus Rules

If these policies are adopted in 2023, the state will see **\$3.3 B** in **cumulative economic** benefits by 2050. They will include:



**\$598 M**

Cumulative public health costs prevented from reduced tailpipe emissions.



**\$255 M**

Net annual fleet savings, including purchase costs and fuel and maintenance expenses.

\*Cost savings account for the capital costs to transition fleet



**\$56,500**

Total savings for the owner of a zero-emission truck or bus over its lifetime, on average.



**\$1.4 B**

Private and public investment into charging infrastructure in New Mexico.



**2,300**

Charging infrastructure investments will create new high-paying jobs associated with construction.

**\$1.8 M**

Cumulative social costs avoided from reduced tailpipe emissions by decreasing transportation emissions by 45% between 2020 - 2050.



**\$84 M**

Growth in GDP by 2035.


